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## PUPIL – COVID-19 PROTOCOL

The school's priorities will always be to adhere to strict hygiene guidelines and social distancing.

### ARRIVAL

- Arrival at school will be staggered for pupils and entry gates identified
- Pupils in S1-S3 should line up in single file according to the markings on the ground at the pupil entrance (next to the school's Main Entrance) to ensure social distancing
- Pupils in S4-S6 should line up outside the main office according to marking on the ground
- Pupils will be directed to the bathroom to wash their hands before going to their class
- The school will operate at one-way system which will be clearly marked. All pupils should always follow this while in the building
- Pupils will remain within the one classroom/teaching area for the duration of their time in school
- When necessary, staff will move between classrooms
- Where pupils are being dropped off, this should be out with the school grounds. Parent/carers should not enter the school grounds personally or with their vehicle

### DEPARTURE

- At the end of the teaching block, pupils will be directed by their teacher to the exit area
- All young people should go directly home and not linger within the school or school grounds
- When pupils are being picked up, this should be done out with the school grounds

### PPE

- All areas being used by staff and pupils will be provided with appropriate PPE. This will include gloves, hand sanitiser, antibacterial wipes, and sprays.

### CLASSROOMS

- Pupils will have a 'home classroom' where all lessons will be taught as far as possible
- Teachers will move from class to class, pupils
- On arrival at class, pupils will be directed to a desk which will be labelled, to ensure that all pupils are 2m apart
- Pupils will be given an antibacterial wipe to wipe down their desk, chair and working area. A disposable bag will be provided to place wipes in
- Pupils should remain seated at their desk and not move around the classroom. The teacher will be the only person who has free movement around the classroom
- At the end of the lesson, pupils should remain seated until directed by the teacher
- Pupils should follow the one-way system while moving around the building at any time
